To test and ensure proper playback of all presentations, **we are requesting that all presentation files (PPT/PDF and associated video files, if needed) be provided to us by TUESDAY 10/26 MIDNIGHT (EDT)**. Please send the files via [WeTransfer](#) to the email address 2016@acadia.org. Utilize the following naming convention for your files:
